At our August meeting, there was discussion concerning the future of the two palm trees standing to the east of Morwell at the end of Commercial Road. The Road Construction Authority has indicated that the trees will stay. In fact, the trees are on land not purchased by the R.C.A. The trees remain as a reminder of the garden surrounding the Morwell butter factory Manager's residence.

Maryvale Road....Leads to Maryvale Paper Mills.

Maude Street...?

Milner Court.....Presumably after the well-known Milner family of Morwell.

Mitchell Court....Dr. Mitchell was an early doctor here in Morwell.

Moira Street....Mrs. Moira Hourigan.

Monash Street....Sir John Monash.

Mulcare Street....Councillor Michael Mulcare, councillor, 1892-1900.

Murphy Street....Councillor William Murphy, councillor, 1892-1894.

Neville Street....Mr. Neville Baldy, Shire Secretary, 1944-1948.

New Street.....Descriptive name. A new street named by the Fleming family.

Newton Court. ?

Norfolk Street... An English county.

Oak Street.....One of the tree group.

O'Grady Street....Cr. Wm. O'Grady, from Boolarra, Shire councillor, 1898-1906.

Olivia Street....Mrs. Olivia Stanton, wife of Sen. Constable Stanton of Morwell.

Patricia Street..?

Papyrus Street...An A.P.M. name. The early Egyptians made paper from papyrus.

Perth Street....Australian warship in the Second World War.

Peter street.....Peter Barry, son of Mr. K. Barry, subdividing owner.

Phyllis Street....Mrs. Phyllis Donaldson, wife of Donald McDonald (see Donald St.)

Polden Crescent...Mr. William Polden, subdividing owner.

Porter Street....Robert Porter selected land at Morwell in 1874.

Quigley Street... The Quigley family came to Morwell in 1878 or earlier.

Rachael Way...?




